Jury Composition & Competition Regulations

INT'L SKI TECHNICAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Jury Composition

1. Composition of Judges

- The competition will be conducted with a panel of five judges.
- Composition:
Three judges will be selected from the host country (ex. Korea) and two judges from the participating foreign country (ex. Japan).
- A total of five judges will be appointed from a pre-approved list based on their technical skills, experience, and fairness.

2. Judging Criteria and Method

- Each judge will evaluate competitors based on the designated scoring items, following fair and consistent standards.
- The scores will be submitted confidentially, and the highest and lowest scores will be excluded. The average of the remaining three scores will determine the final score.
- If there is an abnormally large discrepancy between judges' scores, the issue may be reviewed under the supervision of the Chief Judge.

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Competition Regulation

1. Protest

- In principle, protests against judging results are not permitted.
- However, protests may be conditionally accepted in the event of exceptional external interference, as described below.
- Example:
Physical interference caused by external factors such as spectators, cameras, or other equipment during the run.
- A protest must be submitted verbally or in writing to the Chief Judge or the Competition Committee immediately before the end of the event.
Protests submitted after that time will not be accepted.
- All protest cases will be reviewed and decided immediately by the Chief Judge and the Competition Committee.

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Competition Regulation

2. Athlete's Pledge

- All participants agree to comply with the competition operation and judging regulations, and to accept the results in the spirit of sportsmanship.
- All athletes are considered to have fully understood and agreed to the competition guidelines distributed in advance before participating in the event.

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3. Unsportsmanlike Conduct and Penalties

- If any behavior contrary to sportsmanship is identified, penalties such as warnings or suspension from future competitions may be imposed.
- Examples of unsportsmanlike conduct include:
 - Protesting against judging results, shouting, or showing disrespectful behavior toward judges
 - Actions that interfere with the progress of the competition
 - Deliberate delay of performance or uncooperative attitude
- The decision regarding disciplinary actions will be made by the Chief Judge and the Organizing Committee and may be enforced immediately without prior notice.



Note

These regulations are based on international standards and fairness, and all participants and coaches must respect and adhere to them.
